The following conditions must be met during period of use of meter (failure to comply will result in forfeiture of deposit and meter will be removed for use):

- A customer desiring to use a fire hydrant meter shall first make formal application with the Utility Billing department. Deposit, company information, and personal information are required to complete the application.
- A representative from the company must email, call, or bring the meter to Utility Billing department each month between the 20th and 25th of the month for a reading. Failure to do so will result in a \$100 service call on that month's bill. Email ub-customer-service@wstx.us.
- The customer shall not tamper with, adjust, or repair the meter. Any tampering, attempted adjustments or repairs by the customer or any of agents shall be cause of cancellation of the contract and the deposit will be forfeited and tampering fees may be charged up to \$500.
- Any customer that becomes delinquent on their payment for 30 days or more will forfeit the deposit. The meter will be removed by Public Works, the account closed, and a final bill for all usage paid.
- Until the time the meter is returned and the account is closed the customer will be responsible for all costs of repairs and/or maintenance to the meter and attachments.
- The customer shall install a backflow prevention device onto the fire hydrant meter at the location provided and a 3rd party inspection report must be provided prior to the fire hydrant being unlocked for use.
- The customer shall submit an annual calibration of backflow device if in use for more than 12 months.
- The customer shall notify Public Works if the fire hydrant meter needs to be moved to another location.
