It is agreed by Farmer City permit approval, the permit holder shall be responsible for all property damage associated with any general contractor and/or any subcontractor work operations. This includes but not limited to, damage to all structures, utilities, services, or other public and private infrastructure. Any areas damaged or disturbed during the project as a direct or indirect result of contractor operations shall be restored to a condition equal to or better than the original condition. Cost of said restoration, repair, or replacement shall be borne totally by the permit holder. The responsibility for the repair or replacement of any utility, structure, landscaping, etc., damaged or destroyed by the contractor during mobilization or construction shall be borne solely by the contractor, with no expense being charged to the Farmer City. Prior to acceptance of the repair or replacement, the contractor shall present the Farmer City with a "signoff letter, signed by a responsible official of the owner of the damaged property stating that the repair or replacement is acceptable. All claims, costs, or fees associated with said damage or repairs shall be the responsibility of the permit holder. Any issues not resolved in a timely manner by the permit holder, upon request by Farmer City, repairs will be pursued by the Farmer City at their discretion and the permit holder may be back charged along with any associated legal fees or construction fees to resolve the situation.
