This permit, if granted, satisfies requirement by the City of Bay City's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 14, Animals, Section 14-22, Breeder Animal Permits and shall apply to all persons owning an unaltered dog or cat who are selling, exchanging, or bartering animals.

- * *Reduce unplanned litters and pet overpopulation*
- * *Preserve neighborhood health, safety and quality of life*
