When the valuation of additions, alterations, or repairs to existing dwelling units exceeds \$1,000.00, Sections(s) 420 of the 2019 California Building Code R314 and R315 of the 2019 California Residential Code require that Smoke Alarms and/or Carbon Monoxide Alarms be installed in the following locations:

1. Outside of each separate dwelling unit sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedroom(s).
 - Smoke Alarm and Carbon Monoxide Alarm
2. On every level of a dwelling unit including basements
 - Smoke Alarm and Carbon Monoxide Alarm
3. Within each sleeping room
 - Smoke Alarm
4. Replacement after 10 years from manufacture date, or if date cannot be determined

Carbon Monoxide Alarm is not required in dwellings which do not contain fuel-burning appliance and that do not have an attached garage.

Multi-purpose alarm: Carbon monoxide alarm combined with smoke alarms shall comply with section R314 and R315 and shall be approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshal.

Power Supply: In dwelling units with no commercial power supply, alarm(s) may be solely battery operated. In existing dwelling units, alarm are permitted to be solely battery operated where repairs or alterations do not result in the removal of wall and ceiling finishes or there is no access by means of attic, basement or crawl space. See Sections 420 and R314 and R315. An electrical permit is required for alarms which must be connected to building wiring.

As owner of the above-referenced property. I hereby certify that the alarm(s) referenced above has/have been installed in accordance with the manufacture's instructions and in compliance with the 2019 California Building code and the 2019 California Residential Code. The alarms have been tested and are operational.
