Ordinance No. 2025-#08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4 - GENERAL
LICENSING AND BUSINESS REGULATIONS - OF THE
REVISED ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF
RINGWOOD, SECTION 4-1.7. LICENSE FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Ringwood, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, that Chapter IV - General Licensing and Business Regulations - of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Ringwood is amended as follows:

1. **Section 4-1.7 paragraph a** is amended to provide for a non-refundable application fee of \$100.00 for each individual peddler, hawker, solicitor or canvasser to compensate the Borough of Ringwood for the cost of administering the section and such fees shall not be refunded for any reason.
2. This ordinance is deemed severable and in the event any part hereof is declared void by a court of competent jurisdiction the rest and remainder shall remain in full force and effect.
3. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage.
