NOTICE TO PERMIT APPLICANT

The permit which you have applied for requires the following:

1. Per the Uniform Fire Safety Act, NJSA 52:27D-198.1 and the Rehabilitation Subcode of the Uniform Construction Code, NJAC 5:23-6.4 (f), NJAC 5:23-6.5-11 (f), Smoke detectors will be installed on each level of the dwelling, including the basement. There should be a smoke detector in the vicinity of the bedrooms outside each sleeping area. The smoke detector should be installed as per manufacturer's specifications. Battery powered smoke detectors satisfy this requirement. (The installation of battery powered smoke detectors and those smoke detectors that already exist do not require an inspection. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the homeowner to ensure that the provisions of NJAC referenced above have been met.)
2. Per the New Jersey Administrative Code 5:23-3.20 (c) (Amendment effective April 7, 2003), Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarms must be installed and maintained in the immediate vicinity of each sleeping area, in any guest room or residential dwelling if the building contains either a fuel burning appliance or an attached garage. CO alarms must be installed as per manufacturer's specifications. (The installation of battery powered and plug-in type CO alarms and those CO alarms that already exist do not require an inspection. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the homeowner to ensure that the provisions of NJAC referenced above have been met.)

Exception: If you are installing any hardwired CO alarms or Smoke Detectors, permits and inspection are required.
