Terms of Issuance

1. Vendors providing construction roll-off containers shall register with the City as a contractor of construction roll-off services, shall obtain a permit from the City for each roll-off, and shall pay all applicable fees, including a franchise fee, as set forth in the City of Portland code of Ordinances, Appendix C, Master Fee Schedule.
2. Roll-offs shall be placed in a manner that does not obstruct traffic or sidewalks, damage landscaping, or otherwise create an unsafe condition.
3. The contractor shall not leave loose material, which during collection may fall in streets or property of customers and will collect any loose material that is generated during collection operations.
4. During transport, all Waste Materials shall be contained, covered, and enclosed so that spilling and leaking materials do not occur.
5. The contractor will not use vehicles that leak oil, hydraulic fluid, or other substances, or present an unhygienic or unsafe appearance.
6. Contractor shall be responsible for clean up of any materials, including leaking fluids, spilled from contractor's vehicles.
7. Contractor shall perform all clean-ups of any spilling or leaking from its vehicles within two (2) hours of the spilling or leaking. Contractor shall not leave spill or leak from its vehicles unattended.
8. Contractor will carry absorbent materials to clean up liquid and hydraulic spills or leaks on all trucks.
9. Collection of equipment shall be maintained as to prevent odors. Roll-offs shall be kept in good repair, appearance, and in a sanitary condition. The contractor shall remove any graffiti from the same.
10. Roll-offs shall prominently display The City of Portland permit and sticker and shall bear the name of the contractor at all times.
11. Contractor shall repair or replace private or public property to the extent of its damaged by contractor's negligence or willful misconduct.
12. Any violation of this section shall be deemed a Class C misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, any person so violating it shall be fined a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00). Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

I, the applicant for this permit, warrant the truthfulness of all the information provided in this application and understand that if any of the information provided is incorrect, the permit may be revoked by the City of Portland. I certify that all work will be in full conformity with the City of Portland Ordinances, Terms of Issuance, and applicable State laws. An incomplete application may delay the permit.
