



BRIGHTWATERS HARBOR 2026 RESIDENT RATES

Dear Resident:

Applications are now being accepted for the May 1st – Nov. 30th, 2026 boating season. **Applications must be received at the Village Office by April 3rd. Slips will not be held/guaranteed for applications received after this date. An email & notification will be sent if Board of Trustees open canal sooner than May 1st!**

There are 2 ways to submit Boat applications this year!

- 1) Suggested way is by using the **Mybrightwaters app**, a very convenient way to complete the boat application, upload required documents & convenience of paying online after approved!

- 2) Or Completing the application, with copies of required documentation listed below:

The boat application must be complete, signed and accompanied by:

1. Boat registration in boat owner's name.
2. Car registrations: two (2) resident vehicles maximum.
3. Proof of Residency – Utility bill (PSEGLI, SCWA, Verizon), Homeowners Insurance in boat owner's name. **NOT A TAX BILL**
4. Certificate of liability insurance for \$100,000 in the boat owner's name and naming the Village of Brightwaters as additional insured.
5. Check payable to Village of Brightwaters for full amount.

Daily Canal Mooring Rate**	\$ 25.00 per day

****The above fee is for boats brought in prior to the May 1st opening date without permission and if a boat is left in the canal after the harbor closes, November 30th.**

If you have a berth preference, indicate the berth number, east or west side of the canal. Berth numbers are attached to the bulkhead. As soon as application is approved, you will receive a copy of a signed contract, Boat sticker, rules and regulations and 2 harbor-parking stickers for each of the vehicles on application.

- No carpet or rug permitted on the grass area. All lines, hoses and mats must be tidy and kept clear of the grass.
- Boat Owners shall not discharge oil, fuel or raw or treated sewage into the water.
- **Fueling of boats is strictly prohibited.** Gasoline or Diesel fuel isn't permitted to be carried onto boats from shore
- Boat owners are responsible for disposing of all trash. Please be considerate of homeowners and keep noise to a minimum at night.
- **Working on boat while moored is prohibited.** All boats must be kept in operating order.
