The curb must be constructed as follows: The curb shall consist of a monolithic mixture of concrete developing a compressive strength of 4,000 PSI at 28 days. The coarse aggregate used shall be bluestone. The concrete shall be air-entrained concrete in which the amount of entrained air shall not be less than 3%, or more than 6%. As soon as possible without marring, the finished curb shall be covered with wet burlap, cotton mats or straw and kept moist for three (3) days, or longer if directed. As an alternate, where practical, clear membrane seal coats may be used, which at the end of three (3) days will retain the concrete at least 85% of the original mixing water.

Depth of curb shall be 18 inches and it shall be 8 inches wide at the bottom with the batter on the street side. The upper street side edge shall be finished with a smooth radius. Expansion joints, ½ inch wide, with bituminous cellular type joint filler shall be installed at equal intervals not to exceed 20 feet.

After forms are in place and prior to pouring concrete, call the Engineering Department (973-470-5793) for an inspection of the forms. No concrete is to be poured without inspection and approval of the forms by the City Engineer or his representative.

Properties on County roads may also require County Permits. For further information, please call 973-881-4500.

No work shall be performed during the period of December 1 through April 1. Emergency repairs permitted only with the approval of the City Engineer. No concrete to be poured unless temperature is above freezing 32°F.

The City assumes no responsibility in connection with issuance of this permit. Permit expires 90 days after date of issue. Not valid unless signed by City Engineer.
