

VILLAGE OF RED HOOK

APPLICATION FOR GARAGE/YARD/TAG SALE

I hereby agree to abide by the "Rules and Regulations" of the Village of Red Hook pertaining to a garage/yard/tag sale.

1. A three-day non-renewable permit. Permits may be extended because of inclement weather.
2. Merchandise bought for the express purpose of resale is prohibited.
3. There shall be a limit of three (3) garage/yard/tag sale permits issued to one resident and/or family household during any calendar year.
4. Sales shall be between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm.
5. The permit is automatically revoked should any Village of Red Hook Police Officer or any other police officer empowered by the State of New York, or a village official, state in writing that the garage/yard/tag sale is creating an unsafe traffic condition.
6. No such person shall permit any loud or boisterous conduct on such premises or permit vehicles to impede the passage of the traffic on any roads or streets in the area of the premises where the sale is being conducted.
7. In the event of an emergency, all such persons shall obey reasonable orders from any member of the Police Department or Fire Department in order to maintain the public health, safety and convenience.
8. Local churches, which often hold such sales in their parking lot would be affected by the law as well, and subject to the same regulations as private individuals. Local churches would be exempt from the regulations during community celebrations.
9. Application fee is \$5.00.

It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct a garage/yard/tag sale within the Village of Red Hook without first obtaining a garage/yard/tag sale permit.

ANY PERSON WHO SHALL VIOLATE ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER SHALL, UPON CONVICTION THEREOF, BE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE NOT TO EXCEED MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00), OR BY IMPRISONMENT FOR A TERM NOT TO EXCEED FIFTEEN (15) DAYS FOR EACH VIOLATION.

DEFINITION:

Garage Sale/Yard Sale/Tag Sale (or any other names of such sale) permitted hereunder are those sales of household and personal articles owned, possessed, maintained or controlled by the resident, which will allow neighbors to participate in the sale without being subject to arrest. Sales should be confined to the area within the lot lines and back of the sidewalk, or if there is no sidewalk, at least ten (10) feet back from street lines. It shall be unlawful for any individual to sell or offer for sale, under authority granted by this chapter, property other than personal property.

SIGNS:

Three (3) temporary free standing signs on stakes may be posted on the dates of the sale, subject to the following conditions:

- Each sign shall not exceed six (6) square feet.
- Each sign is to be removed each day at the close of the sale activities or by the end of daylight, whichever first occurs.
- Signs not to be placed on any utility poles, sign posts or street signs of any kind.
