Please extend my fire plan review/permit for a maximum of 180 days as I am unable to continue construction at this time due to circumstances beyond my control. The following is an explanation of such circumstances:

Time limitation of application, Section 16-5.01.100 City of Victorville Development Code

"An application for a permit for any proposed work or operation shall be deemed to have been abandoned 180 days after the date of filing, unless such application has been diligently prosecuted or a permit shall have been issued; except that the fire code official is authorized to grant one or more extensions of time for additional periods not exceeding 90 days each. The extension shall be requested in writing and justifiable cause demonstrated."

Permit Expiration, Section 105.3.1 California Fire Code

Construction permits shall automatically become invalid unless the work authorized by such permit is

- a. *commenced within 180 days after its issuance,*
- b. *or if the work authorized by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time the work is commenced.*

Before such work recommences, a new permit shall be first obtained and the fee to recommence work, if any, shall be one-half the amount required for a new permit for such work, provided that changes have not been made and will not be made in the original construction documents for such work, and provided further that such suspension or abandonment has not exceeded one year. Permits are not transferable and any change in occupancy, operation, tenancy or ownership shall require that a new permit be issued.

In order to resume work on a permit after a period of time in excess of one year, the permittee shall be subject to a new permitting process and is required to pay full permit fees.
