Contact the Alliance Engineering, Building and Zoning Department at (330) 823-5122, 504 E. Main St., Alliance OH, 44601. Provide the following information:

- Closest cross street.
- Type of repair work being done.
- Property owner's contact information.
- Contractor's contact information.
- Include a North arrow.
- Contractor must follow City of Alliance Roadway Excavation and Repair Standard Drawings and other applicable standards.
- Contractor must call for inspections.
- For single-family residential repairs, if the Contractor performs saw cuts and removal, Contractor backfills excavation to flush street level and is responsible for maintaining excavation until backfill/repair invoice is paid and permanent repair can be made. The City of Alliance will return to perform concrete and/or asphalt repair.
- The \$35.00 fee is for residential or commercial repairs and is based on 1-3 consecutive parcels. One \$35.00 fee will be charged per household or per commercial business.
- For large residential and commercial projects involving 4 or more parcels (consecutive or non-consecutive) a tiered fee structure can be found on the City of Alliance website under Engineering Department Fees (under Engineering Services on the fee sheet). These costs are based on the Engineer's estimate of the project (or bid) for underground construction within the right-of-way only.
- **BACKFILL/REPAIRS:**
 - Concrete and/or asphalt repair costs are as posted under Engineering Fees.
 - The \$35.00 permit does not include the repair costs for concrete and/or asphalt to be performed by the City of Alliance.
 - For large projects with 4 or more parcels, including multi-family, commercial, industrial sites, and new installations, the Contractor is responsible for full final repair of the roadway, sidewalks, and yards.
- Overtime inspection rates are as posted online under Engineering Fees. For work requiring inspections prior to 8:00 a.m. or after 4:00 p.m., the contractor will be charged applicable overtime inspection rates.
