GARAGE SALES
Van Municipal Code Chapter 12
Article VII. Ordinance 296
Sales on Residential Property Section 22-21

- (a) It is unlawful for an individual to sell their personal property or the personal property of another on their residential property without a permit issued by the City.
- (b) The City Secretary shall issue a permit for the purposes of permitting an individual to sell personal property on their residential property, provided the following conditions and requirements are met:
- (1) Such sale shall not be conducted longer than 72 hours, or three days in length; and
 - (2) Such sale permits may only be issued at the same individual twice a year; and
 - (3) Such sale permits shall be issued at the same address, location, or building twice a year.
- (c) Garage sale or yard sign maybe placed 24 hours prior to the sale and removed 24 hours after the sale.
- (d) It shall be unlawful to place any sign, banner or placard across, upon, or over any street or alley or upon any utility pole within the city's street right-of-way. The term "street right-of-way" shall mean from the curb line of a street back to where the city ownership ends, provided, however, organizations or other clubs which are promoting civic activities which are beneficial to the community shall be exempted from this prohibition.
- (e) Any person convicted of a violation of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00, nor more than \$200.00.
