Investigation of Peddler's License must be completed by all applicants.

In accordance with Borough of Wallington Ordinance 2020-010 in particular Section 272-3 the Borough of Wallington will investigate all applications for Peddler's License. To enable the investigator to complete his investigation please supply the following information:

1. Name and permanent and local address of the applicant.
2. If the licensed activity is to be carried out at a fixed location, the address and description of the premises.
3. If a vehicle is to be used, its description including the license number.
4. If the applicant is employed by another, the name and address of the employer. Together with credentials establishing the exact relationship.
5. The days of the week and the hours of the day during which the licensed activity will be conducted.
6. A description of the nature of the business and the goods, property or services to be sold or supplied.
7. A statement as to whether the applicant has been convicted of any crime or the violation of any Municipal Ordinance other than traffic offenses and, if so, the date and place of the offense, and the punishment or penalty imposed.
8. Appropriate evidence as to the good character and business responsibility of the applicant so that an investigator may properly evaluate their character and responsibility.

In addition to the above information all applicants not personally known to the investigator shall be fingerprinted at Police Headquarters for proper identification.
