This includes three (3) representatives appointed by the Merced County Board of Supervisors (County-at-Large, Western Rural, and Northern Rural), and one representative appointed by the City Councils from each of the 6 Cities in Merced County (Atwater, Dos Palos, Gustine, Livingston, Los Banos, and Merced).

Board of Trustee meetings are held on the third Tuesday of each month at 4:00 pm. Meetings alternate between our Merced Office, located at 3478 Beachwood Drive, Merced, and our Westside Depot, located at 14100 Deepwell Road, Dos Palos.
