



SUGAR LAND MUNICIPAL COURT
REQUEST FOR DEFERRED DISPOSITION (PROBATION)

Deferred disposition (probation) is an option that may allow your case to be dismissed and prevent a conviction from appearing on your record if you successfully complete the requirements ordered by the judge. You may request probation online, by mail, or in person at the clerk window. You do not need to appear before the judge to make this request.

HOW TO REQUEST PROBATION

To request probation, you must submit this signed request on or before your appearance date and include:

- Payment of the required cost
- A copy of your valid Texas driver's license (*unless you are requesting probation for Driving While License Invalid*)
- A copy of your automobile insurance card or proof of financial responsibility showing you as a covered driver

After completing probation, you may submit your compliance documents without appearing in court.

You are NOT ELIGIBLE for probation if:

1. You have a commercial driver's license (CDL) or if you had a CDL at the time of the alleged violation;
2. The violation is alleged to have occurred in a construction zone with workers present.

You are NOT ELIGIBLE to use this request for probation and must appear in court to request probation if:

3. You do NOT currently have liability insurance coverage in which you are named as a covered driver;
4. You were under 17 years of age at the time of the alleged violation;
5. You are currently on deferred disposition (probation) in ANY court.

DEFENDANT STATEMENT

By requesting probation, you are confirming that:

- You are the person named on this citation
- You were at least 17 years old at the time of the offense
- You have a valid Texas driver's license (*or will provide one at the end of probation for DWLI*)
- You do not have a CDL
- You have valid liability insurance and are a covered driver
- The offense did not occur in a construction zone
- You were not charged with speeding 25 mph or more over the posted speed limit
- You are submitting the required court costs
- You understand that failure to comply with the court's order may result in a conviction being entered on your driving record

ADMONISHMENTS AND WAIVERS

- You waive your right to a jury trial and enter a plea of no contest
- I acknowledge receipt of notice of the charge against me by receipt of the citation in this case and **waive any right to timely notice of a complaint** under Article 45A.101(g), Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.
- I acknowledge my right to discovery under Article 39.14 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure and hereby waive the viewing of any discovery available from the State for this case.
- I am knowingly, intelligently, and freely agreeing to waive my right to an appeal and acknowledge that any conviction that may result from the plea agreement will be final.
