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LIQUOR LICENSE - AGREEMENT FORM

The City of Bridgeton, a municipal corporation of St. Louis County, Missouri, hereinafter referred to as "Bridgeton" and _____,

(Name(s) of person applying for Liquor License)

hereinafter referred to as "Operator", hereby covenant and agree to as of the ____ day of _____, 2026, that:

1. Operator has applied for a liquor license for a business known as, _____, to be located at the premises known and numbered as _____.
2. Operator intends to operate a restaurant serving full meals at said premises, and Bridgeton has heretofore issued a special use permit to operate a full-service restaurant at said premises, and Operator has requested a permit for the sale of alcoholic beverages at said restaurant.
3. In the event the Bridgeton City Council shall issue the liquor license, the liquor license will be subject to the following terms, conditions, and restrictions:
 - a. The liquor license and its continued validity shall be conditional upon the continued validity, force, and effect of the aforesaid special use permit, as it may be modified from time to time, for the operation of a restaurant at said premises.
 - b. Operator shall not exercise any rights under such liquor license until Operator shall have a full-service restaurant in operation at said premises.
 - c. The liquor license and its continued validity shall be conditional upon dollar volume of the annual sale of food exceeding either (1) \$75,000.00 or (2) the annual sale of liquor in dollar volume.
 - d. Bridgeton may from time to time audit the records of Operator to determine the dollar amount of monthly sales of food and liquor.
 - e. Operator shall maintain for a period of at least three (3) years, records which accurately reflect the dollar amount of monthly sales of food and liquor and shall make such records available during normal business hours to the auditor selected by Bridgeton upon reasonable notice and request thereof.



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- f. In the event that at any time Operator shall cease to have a valid special use permit for the operation of a restaurant on said premises, or shall cease actually to operate a full-service restaurant on said premises, or shall sell more liquor than food in any year, as measured in dollar volume and have less than \$75,000.00 in food sales in such year, the aforesaid liquor license shall automatically terminate and be revoked without further action by Bridgeton.
 - g. Bridgeton may revoke or suspend an existing liquor license or may refuse to grant a renewal liquor license if Operator fails to keep such books, records, and accounts as required by this agreement, or fails to supply such books, records and accounts to Bridgeton or its auditors or its other designated representatives for the purpose of an audit upon reasonable notice and request thereof.
 - h. The following statement shall be placed on said liquor license: "This Liquor License is subject to the terms and provisions of an Agreement between the holder hereof and the City of Bridgeton".
4. Operator agrees that in the event they shall cease to hold a valid special use permit for the operation of a restaurant on said premises or shall cease to operate a full-service restaurant on said premises or shall sell more liquor than food in any year by dollar volume and have less than \$75,000.00 in food sales in such year, Operator shall surrender to Bridgeton aforesaid liquor license.
5. This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective heirs, successors, and assigns.
