NEW CUMBERLAND BOROUGH DUMPSTER / POD PERMIT INFORMATION

THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS SUPPLIED TO ANY PERSON WHO WISHES TO PLACE A DUMPSTER OR SIMILAR ITEM ON A TEMPORARY BASIS ON A PUBLIC STREET OR ON PRIVATE PROPERTY IN NEW CUMBERLAND BOROUGH:

- Any person intending to place a Commercial Trash Collection Device (dumpster) or POD or similar device on any public street or alley or on private property within the Borough for any amount of time is required to apply for and obtain a permit.
- A completed application returned to New Cumberland Borough AND a Permit must be issued before a Dumpster / POD or similar may be placed on a public street or alley or on private property.
- The applicant agrees to fully indemnify and hold harmless the Borough of New Cumberland and assumes all liability for damages or injury occurring to any person or property through or in consequence of any act or omission of anyone associated with the placement of the dumpster / POD or similar on the roadway or on private property.
- The Dumpster / POD or similar may not:
 - o Block any portion of a public sidewalk or walkway
 - o Extend into the travel lane of traffic.
 - o Be placed within twenty (20) feet of a crosswalk, intersection, driveway or traffic control device or within (25) feet of the approach of a stop sign or traffic control device.
 - o Interfere with reasonable sight distances or adversely impact traffic or pedestrian safety.
- No Dumpster / POD or similar may be placed on a public street or alley or on private property without a Permit.
- The Dumpster / POD subject to the Permit is required to be illuminated with a warning light, light reflector or a reflectorized material on the front and rear surfaces in such a manner to indicate the height and width of it and shall be visible for a distance of not less than three hundred (300') feet between the hours of sunset and sunrise.

o It is your responsibility to supply the illuminated barricades or reflectorized materials or obtain them from any source you wish as long as these items meet the requirements of the Ordinance.

- Hazardous Materials are not permitted to be placed in a Dumpster / POD or similar for which a permit is required.
- Dumpsters must be covered with a tarp or similar weather resistant cover when not in use to prevent scattering and vermin invasion.
- Dumpsters / PODs or similar must have adequate restraints to prevent inadvertent movement.
- The fee for the Permit is \$15.00, payable to the Borough of New Cumberland with the Application and is non-refundable.
- Once an application is received, a borough official shall conduct an assessment of the application. In the interest of traffic and pedestrian safety, the borough may approve, approve with modifications or deny the application.
- A Permit is valid for seven (7) days.
