An application may be deemed incomplete if the applicant fails to include all required information and materials.

***This cover sheet does not apply for wireless application modifications under Section 6409(a) Eligible Facilities Request.**

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

Applicants may submit one (1) AB 965 batched wireless application per appointment, inasmuch as the population of City of Chino Hills is above 50,000 population, a single AB 965 batched application may contain up to Fifty (50) individual AB 965-qualified site applications or as agreed upon within the executed Master Communications License Agreement (MCLA).

- ☐ A separate exhibit (labeled "Batch Locations") that contains (a) a site plan identifying the location of each site; (b) the address of each site; (c) the latitude and longitude (WGS 84) of each site; (d) pole identification number, if applicable; (e) the pole type, if applicable; (f) the Applicant's site number/name.

Each wireless application within an AB 965 batch must individually meet all the requirements for a complete application that includes, without limitation, the payment of individual wireless application fees for each application within the batch.

For each Batch:

- If any SWF application is incomplete the entire batch shall be deemed incomplete, unless otherwise agreed upon between the City and the applicant.
- If any SWF application is withdrawn or deemed withdrawn the entire batch shall be deemed withdrawn unless otherwise agreed-upon between the City and the applicant.
- If any SWF application requires a tolling agreement, the tolling agreement must cover the entire batch, unless otherwise agreed-upon between the City and the applicant.

Each wireless application shall be an individual PDF containing:
