VII. PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

1. One or two family dwelling containing not more than 3500 square feet of building area.
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the mechanical official to be of a minor nature.
3. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$ 15,000.00

If work being performed is described above, answer A to section IV, Plans not required

Plans are required for all other types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer, licensed pursuant to Act. No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal

Note: Plans are required for all commercial projects.

PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

X. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL:

Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the City of Hudson. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

**Note: All new installations require the Manf. Spec.'s (UL) to be submitted prior to inspection
(ie, furnace, boiler, woodburners, fireplaces, water heater)**

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT:

A permit remains valid for one (1) year from date of issuance. Permits may be renewed. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six (6) months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six (6) months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED.

PLAN REVIEWS:

All new residential dwellings. All commercial / industrial work. Residential remodeling projects deemed necessary by code inspector.

ALL MECHANICAL WORK REQUIRES A FINAL INSPECTION WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ITEMS MARKED (*)

STREET NUMBERS MUST BE POSTED AT ROAD PRIOR TO INSPECTIONS

MINIMUM 3 INCH LETTERS

PERMIT SHOULD BE AVAILABLE ON THE JOB SITE
