SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR LOT LINE ADJUSTMENTS

APPLICANT PRESUBMITTAL CHECKLIST

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REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

All items are required at the time of submittal and shall be submitted in electronic format.

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1. General Planning Application: The application form shall be signed by the project applicant and property owner. If the lot line adjustment involves lots owned by several owners, each owner must sign the application form. Refer to the Planning Forms and Handouts webpage.

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2. Lot Line Adjustment Authorization and Certificate of Ownership Form: Page 3 of this handout

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3. Application Fee: Current application fee as listed in the City's adopted fee schedule.

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4. Current Preliminary Title Report: Title report for the project property(ies) prepared within the last year.

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5. Site Survey: A site survey prepared by a licensed land surveyor.

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6. Legal Descriptions and Closure Calculations: A legal description and closure and area calculation for each proposed adjusted property, which shall be stamped and signed by a licensed land surveyor or qualified civil engineer.

7. Plat Map: An 8.5" x 11" size plat map in a single, flattened/compressed PDF file not exceeding 125 MB prepared by a licensed land surveyor or qualified civil engineer containing the following information:

- Date, north arrow, and scale
- Lot layout showing the dimensions and bearings of each lot. Clearly indicate the new property lines and existing property lines to be removed/moved.
- Existing and proposed lot areas (square feet).
- Names of the property owners and the preparer(s) of the plan/map.
- Location and names of all adjoining and contiguous highways, streets, alleys and public ways.
- Locations, widths, type and purpose of all existing and proposed easements.
- Letter or number for each lot.
- Assessor Parcel Number for each existing lot.



8. Site Plan: An 11" x 17" size site plan in a single, flattened/compressed PDF file not exceeding 125 MB prepared by a licensed land surveyor or qualified civil engineer containing the following information:

- North arrow and scale
- Name, business address and telephone number of the person who prepared the plans.
- Location and names of all adjoining and contiguous highways, streets, alleys, and public ways.
- Approximate widths, locations, and type of all existing and proposed easements.
- Lot layout and approximate dimensions and square footage of each lot before and after the adjustment (show meets and bounds).
- Letter or number for each lot.
- Locations of all existing buildings, utilities, and other improvements.
- Lot coverage and floor area calculations for all structures to remain on each lot.
- Setbacks of existing buildings and other improvements from the existing and proposed property lines (only those buildings which are to remain).
- Location, size and type of all existing trees greater than 4" in diameter measured at 48" above natural grade.
