

Livestock Application

Livestock within the city is prohibited without City Council Approval. Article II Livestock defines livestock as: any horse, cattle, swine, sheep, pony, goat, or other animal or fowl except dogs, cats, birds or animals commonly classified as pets. All livestock requests must be submitted for City Council approval, except rabbits, egg laying chickens or ducks, which are approved by the Community Development Department per council designation. All livestock must meet the standards outlined in this application. Applications are not considered complete unless they include:

- A completed and signed application
- Narrative describing *"particularly the place where the applicant proposes to keep such livestock, the number thereof, the distance from such place to the public streets on each side and the distance to the dwelling houses upon lands adjoining such proposed place."*
- Sketch plan of shelter on property & location on property (including distances from public streets and dwellings described above).

Sanitation: Livestock shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition and in accordance with any applicable statutes, ordinances, rules and regulations established by the department or agency including, but not limited to, the local health department and the Michigan Department of Agriculture & Rural Development.

Running at large: No livestock may be permitted to run at large within the city.

Standards for rabbits or egg laying chickens/ducks:

- No more than 6 rabbits or egg laying chickens/ducks or combination of resulting in no more than six total
- Must be zoned and occupied as a single family residential use
- Shall be provided with a covered, predator-proof enclosure that is thoroughly ventilated, designed to be easily accessible, cleaned and maintained by the owners and shall be at least 2 square feet in size for each animal. No more than 2 enclosures are permitted on a single property.
- Shall not be located in any front or side yards, nor shall they be closer than 3 feet to any property line or less than 20 feet away from any residential structure located on any adjacent property.

Signature: By signing this application, an applicant is acknowledging the following:

- Livestock shall not be detrimental to public health, safety or welfare
- Any livestock permit may be revoked by City Council or the City Manager for violations to Article II – Livestock of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Cadillac, any terms and conditions of any permit, or where there is a danger to the public health, safety and welfare.
