DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE:

- ☐ A Compliance Certificate from a REScheck TM Report clearly indicating compliance with either the Prescriptive Path or Simulated Building Performance Option of 2025 ECCC NYS, or a compliance certificate using the R406 ERI Path of the 2025 ECCC NYS.
- ☐ A report confirming that the Residential Dwelling is in compliance with Section 402.5.1 and Table R402.5.11 (Air Barrier, Air Sealing and Insulation Installation) and in compliance with Section R402.5 Air Leakage and the Air Leakage Mandatory Test as per section R402.5.1.2 of the Energy Code.
- ☐ A report confirming that the Residential Dwelling is in compliance with Section R403.3 (Duct Systems) and the results from testing required in Section R403.3.7 are satisfactory.

*STANDARD RENOVATED RESIDENTIAL BUILDING means an existing Residential Building as defined by the ECCCNY for which a building permit application is submitted for the proposed demolition, addition, (or a combination thereof) of less than 100% of the existing Thermal Envelope. Thermal Envelope is the components of a home (which may include ceilings, walls, windows, doors, floors and foundation) that separate the conditioned spaces from unconditioned spaces, ambient conditions or outdoors.
