THE APPLICATION SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY A SITE PLAN SHOWING THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1. THE EXACT DIMENSIONS OF THE LOT WHERE THE PROPOSED WELL IS TO BE LOCATED.
2. LOCATION AND DIMENSIONS OF ALL BUILDINGS ON THE PROPERTY.
3. LOCATION OF ALL UTILITY EASEMENTS AND EXACT DISTANCES BETWEEN PROPOSED WELL AND EASEMENTS.
4. LOCATION OF AND EXACT DISTANCE FROM PROPOSED WELL TO ANY SEPTIC TANKS, SEWER LINES, WATER LINES, UNDERGROUND TELEPHONE LINES, STREETS, ALLEYS, ANIMAL OR LIVESTOCK PENS, DUMP GROUNDS, BAY OR PONDS, AND ANY FLOOD ZONE AREA.

- **NO PERMIT WILL BE ISSUED IF PROPERTY IS WITHIN 200 FEET OF THE CITY UTILITY LINE.**
- **PROPERTY MUST BE CONNECTED TO CITY WATER SYSTEM IF WITHIN 200 FEET OF UTILITY LINE.**
- **NO PERMIT WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL THE ABOVE INFORMATION IS SUBMITTED BY THE APPLICANT.**

I ATTEST THAT ALL THE WORK WILL BE PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW AND ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BAYSIDE. THE CITY MAY, IN WRITING, SUSPEND OR REVOKE A PERMIT WHENEVER IT IS DETERMINED THAT THE PERMIT WAS ISSUED IN ERROR, OR ON THE BASIS OF INCORRECT INFORMATION SUPPLIED, OR WHEN IT IS DETERMINED THAT THE WATER WELL IS IN VIOLATION OF ANY ORDINANCE, REGULATION, OR STATE LAW.

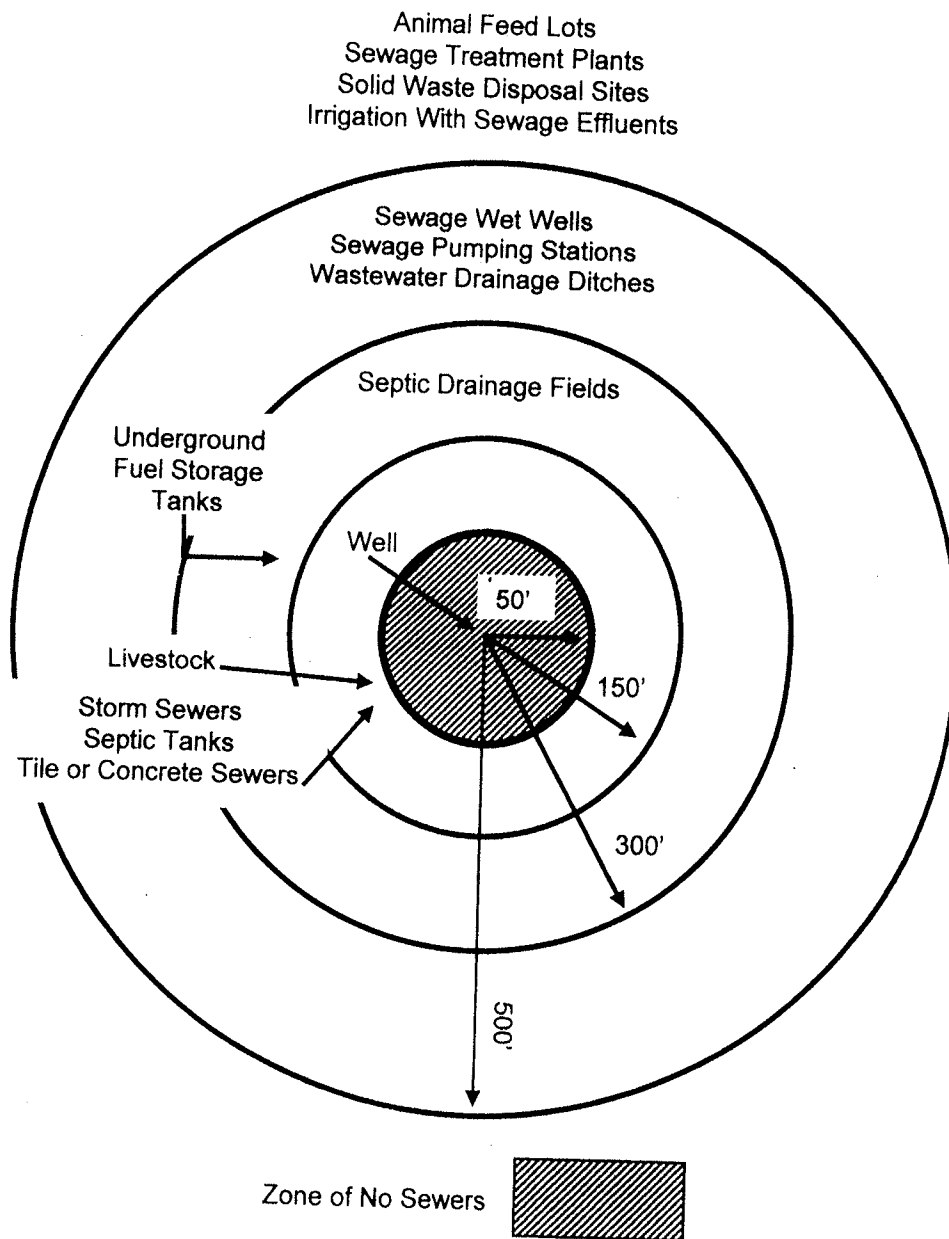


Fig. 4-5 Required Safe Distance from a Well
