CONDITIONS: This permit is hereby granted with the understanding that the contractor shall work in accordance with plans and specifications; and that all general and detail work connected with such installation, alteration, or repair of any such plumbing shall be done in strict compliance with the ordinances of the Village of Palos Park, Illinois.

PLUMBING INSPECTION: Site cannot be backfilled until inspected and approved by the Village. The request for inspection should be made at least 48 hours in advance of such requested inspection. Should it be necessary for a re-inspection by reason of incomplete or rejected work, a fee of \$50.00 shall be charged for such added inspection; such fee to be paid to the Village Collector.

PERMIT FEES: \$100.00

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Special Assessments or Tap-In Fees are paid to date.
2. Plumbers Cash Bond of \$500.00 posted at time of permit application. Cash Bond is refundable upon project completion.
3. Submit Plat of survey or Site Plan along with permit application. Please indicate the location of any well and discarded septic tanks.

4. The following materials and connections should be specified:
 - (a) "T" clean out required where house sewer connects to Village stub at street.
 - (b) 6" x 4" non-shear mission coupling and "T" connection with cleanout outside the foundation at the 6" line.
 - (c) "T" Clean outs needed every 150 feet as needed between house and street connection.
 - (d) 6" x 6" mission coupling or matching pipe connection at point of connection to Village system. If no stub, new connection to public sewer requires 6" "T" connection and non-shear couplings.
 - (e) 6" pipe to meet code.
 - (f) SDR 26 or equivalent.
5. All discharges must go to the sewer, including those from floor drains. Discharges from footing tile, sump pumps, and downspouts are excluded and can not be connected to the sewer.
6. It is the contractor's responsibility to have all septic and aerobic tanks pumped, crushed, and filled with sand or stone. Receipt for work must be shown.
7. Allow 24 hours to issue permit and 48 hours for inspections.
8. Utility Billing fees begin the day of installation. If the owner listed is not the recipient of the bill please notify the Utility Department 708-671-3721.
