The City does allow for temporary or permanent electrical service to be released for connection by the public utility provider, subsequent to the provisions of this affidavit, any required inspection, and electrical contractor duties to validate the following conditions;

1. National Electrical Code (NEC) compliant service equipment, distribution panel, devices, minimally a single GFCI branch circuit protected outlet, and termination of all branch circuit wiring.
2. Structure must be weather tight and secured for access at all openings.
3. Service is ready for connection to public utilities.

This service release is permitted per the request of the electrical contractor to provide electrical service for limited construction activity use, and/or testing and validation of NEC compliant installation and operation. Any other uses are prohibited.

The Utility provider must receive application for the service connection and approve the connection per the provider's specific requirements.

The electrical contractor does hereby affirm this electrical service complies with minimum NEC installation and operation requirements and that the contractor shall be solely responsible to validate the service is in compliance with NEC and to further hold harmless and indemnify the City and its agents against any liability, loss or damages in association with this electrical service, including but not limited to uses, components, connections and the effects thereof.
