- The applicant must be the owner or lawful tenant of the property.
- The applicant must acquire a Yard Sale Permit by noon the day before the sale
- The applicant must submit this application along with all the required documentation as follows:
- Proof of ownership; if you do not own the property, a copy of your lease/rental agreement
- Copy of your driver's license
- Sales are limited to two (2) per calendar year, per residential lot.
- No such sales shall be conducted for a longer period than 72 hours consecutively.
- No wares, goods, or merchandise shall be advertised or offered for sale, or swap, or given away, except goods, wares, and merchandise owned by the property owner or the tenant conducting the sale.
- No goods, wares, or merchandise shall be purchased by the owner or tenant for the purpose of selling, swapping, or giving away same at such a sale.
- Each yard sale may erect a maximum of three signs, one on the property where the sale is to occur and two additional signs for directional purposes. All such signs shall be erected only on private property with the approval of the owner or occupant of that property.
- Permits issued should be maintained on site for the duration of the sale so that it is available for inspection by City of Hiram staff.
