Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act. No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal except:

1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area.
2. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000

V. CONTRACTOR SIGNATURE

VII. FEE CLARIFICATION

ITEM #17 MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE.

When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites. When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee, and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor. When setting a HUD mobile home or a pre-manufactured mobile home or a pre-manufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

VIII. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the city providing as much notice as possible. The City will need the job location and permit number. When a permit is issued, the permit number will be prefixed by an PE.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit, or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTIONS. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
