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BUSINESS PERMIT FOR DOOR-TO-DOOR VENDORS

- Permit required for each individual or organization applying
- Copy of drivers license or state-issued ID required
- Two photographs of each applicant, measuring at least 1.5" x 1.5" and showing the head and shoulders of the applicant in a clear and distinguishing manner, which shall have been taken within the preceding 60 days before filing the application
- Proof of possession and copy of any license or permit which, under federal, state, or local laws or regulations, the applicant is required to have in order to conduct the proposed solicitation or canvassing
- Fee per schedule listed in Ordinance 25-05 Business Permits for Door to Door Vendors

If the applicant is:

Employed by another, the name and physical street address (not a post office box) of the Employer; or

If the applicant, upon any sales or order obtained, will demand, accept or receive payment or the deposit of money in advance of final delivery, the bond described in Ordinance 25-05 Section 4 will be required.

If the applicant has pled guilty or nolo contendere to, or has been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor involving fraud, deceit, misrepresentation, a sex offense, trafficking a controlled substance, or any act of violence against persons or property within five years preceding the date of application, a description of each such conviction or plea and the date of the offense

If the applicant claims that the solicitation activity is to be conducted on behalf of a non profit organization, proof of such status shall be attached to the application.

If the applicant is an entity that sponsors or employs minors as solicitors and is submitting one application, the information set forth in Ordinance 25-05 Section 3(b).
