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The Anaconda-Deer Lodge County has resolved a regular right-of-way construction schedule as follows:

1. Regular right-of-way construction season shall be April 15, 2025, to October 15, 2025, unless special circumstances warrant. Special permission must be granted in writing by the ADLC Road Foreman.
2. Boring under paved streets is required unless all other means have been exhausted.
3. Emergency work shall be permitted outside the normal construction season; however, notification and justification must be provided to the ADLC Road Department and Planning Department within 24 hours of the emergency work being initiated.
