



Dear Sir or Madam,

Enclosed is a Renewal Business License Application for the 2025 business year. If you are planning to do any business in Wasco, you are required to fill out the application completely and return it with the appropriate fees no later than January 31, 2025. Any application and fees received after January 31, 2025, will be subject to a 10% penalty fee, and an additional 10% penalty fee for each month delinquent thereafter.

In addition, section 5.04.60 of the Municipal Code also states the following:

To all delinquent license taxes, there shall be added a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the amount of the tax due, plus an additional ten percent (10%) for each month delinquent thereafter providing that the amount of any penalty shall in no event exceed one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the license tax due.

If your company will no longer be conducting business in Wasco, it is very important that you fill out the Business License Renewal Form and initial the Non-Renewal Statement.

The City of Wasco appreciates all those who do business in our community and is making every effort to continue to effectively serve our business community during the post COVID-19 Pandemic. All City Departments are currently open to the public. All services are available online or via phone and e-mail. Incluida esta una Solicitud de Licencia de Negocio para la renovacion del 2025. Si usted planea enhacer cualquier negocio en Wasco se requiere llenar la solicitud completamente y devolverla con los honorarios correspondientes a lo mas tardar el 31 de Enero de 2025. Cualquier solicitud y honorarios recibidos despues del 31 de Enero de 2025 estaran sujetos a una penalidad del 10%, y a una penalidad de 10% adicional por cada mes delincuente despues.

El artículo 5.04.60 del Código Municipal también establece lo siguiente:

A todos los impuestos de licencia morosos se añadirá una penalización del diez por ciento (10%) del monto del impuesto adeudado, más un diez por ciento adicional (10%) por cada mes de moroso a partir de entonces, siempre que el importe de cualquier sanción no exceda en ningún caso del cien por cien (100%) del importe del impuesto de licencia adeudado.

Si su empresa ya no realizara negocio en Wasco, es muy importante que complete el Formulario de renovacion de licencia commercial y pongo sus iniciales en la Declaracion de "no renovacion."

UPCOMING CHANGES: AB 1826

Enclosed is a Business License Renewal Form for the year of 2025. If you are still planning to do any business in Wasco you are required to fill out the renewal form completely and return it with the appropriate fees no later than January 31, 2025. Any application and fees received after January 31, 2025 will be subject to a penalty of 10% of the tax due plus an additional 10% for each month delinquent thereafter.

If you are no longer going to be engaged in business in Wasco it is very important you fill out the Non-Renewal Form enclosed and send it back with your company name, signature, and a short statement stating you will no longer be doing business within the City of Wasco city limits.

Payments are accepted by phone with a debit/credit card, by mail with a check/money order and in person with cash, debit/credit card and check/money order. Be advised if sending renewal application and payment by mail please ensure the application is complete and the amount of the payment is correct to avoid any delays in receiving the business license certificate.

What is AB 1826?

Assembly Bill 1826 (AB 1826) is a law enacted by the State of California that requires qualifying businesses and Multi-Family dwellings (5 units or more) to participate in an organics recycling program; required compliance is based on a tiered system of how much organic waste the organization generates.

Business License Supplement

SB 205 Compliance

(For Businesses Inside the Wasco City Limits only)

Pursuant to SB 205, businesses applying for an initial business license or business license renewal that are subject to the NPDES permit program under the State Water Resources Control Board and the California Regional Water Quality Control Boards are required to demonstrate enrollment with the NPDES permit program by providing specified information on the Business License application.

To determine if your business is subject to NPDES requirements please read below from the State Water Resources Control Board Website (https://www.waterboards.ca.gov/water_issues/programs/npdes/)

“Do you discharge pollutants from a point source to a water of the United States? If so, you need an NPDES permit.

As authorized by the [Clean Water Act \(CWA\)](#), the NPDES Permit Program controls water pollution by regulating point sources that discharge pollutants into waters of the United States. Point sources are discrete conveyances such as pipes or man-made ditches. Examples of pollutants include, but are not limited to, rock, sand, dirt, and agricultural, industrial, and municipal waste discharged into waters of the United States. See [section 122.2 of 40 Code of Federal Regulations \(C.F.R.\)](#) for the actual definitions of point source, pollutant, and water of the United States.

The NPDES Program is a federal program which has been delegated to the State of California for implementation the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) and the nine Regional Water Quality Control Boards (Regional through Water Boards), collectively Water Boards. In California, NPDES permits are also referred to as waste discharge requirements (WDRs) that regulate discharges to waters of the United States.”
