

## **GUIDELINES FOR BOND TO MOVE HEAVY EQUIPMENT IN AND OUT OF CITY LIMITS**

- 1. OBTAIN AN INDEMNITY BOND, NOT LESS THAN \$50,000.00. THE CITY WILL SET THE AMOUNT DUE ON A BOND.**
- 2. TYPE OF VEHICLES BEING USED, WITH LICENSE PLATE NUMBERS.**
- 3. ROADS TO BE USED.**
- 4. WEIGHT OF VEHICLES.**
- 5. KNOWN DISTANCE TO BE TRAVELED.**
- 6. REVIEW OF ROADS BEFORE AND AFTER.**
- 7. PAY A ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) PER TRUCK FOR PERMIT FEE.**

**\*\*\* (A COPY OF THE PERMIT MUST BE CARRIED IN ALL TRUCKS OPERATING UNDER ISSUED PERMIT.) \*\*\***

**TRUCKS ARE NOT TO OPERATE DURING THE HOURS OF 7:00 – 8:30 AM AND 2:30 – 4:00 PM**

**(Please be aware of all traffic signs in the area)**



Jones Creek reserves the right to revoke the permit at any time, in the sole discretion of Jones Creek, for interests of public health, safety or welfare or for failure to pay road damages upon demand, or for any other reason deemed sufficient by Jones Creek.

By allowing a permit holder to operate a vehicle over Jones Creek roads when the vehicle exceeds applicable weight limits, Jones Creek is acting within its police power to not only regulate the usage of those roads but also to allow the permit holder to do that which would otherwise be illegal. As such, Jones Creek's grant of authority to the permit holder under section 623.018 is a license/permit instead of a contract, as those terms are used in Texas law.

This permit is only good for 90 days per City Ordinance #466. Fees established in Ordinance #500.

This permit shall be in effect for a period of 90 days from the day of issuance, unless sooner revoked by the City of Jones Creek.

This temporary permit is granted upon the condition that the Applicant has agreed to pay all damages to Jones Creek caused by use of said roads, by applicant and applicant's employees, agents, and subcontractors including damages to bridges and other structures on said roads.

Payment of damages shall in no way limit, discharge or diminish the obligation of Applicant to pay for any future damage caused to City Roads by Applicant, his employees, agents or subcontractors, nor shall payment of any such damage limit the right of Jones Creek to revoke this permit in its sole discretion.

It is a further condition of this permit that Applicant, applicant's employees, agents and subcontractors shall limit all loads transported under this permit to the maximum load per axle, overall gross weight, and dimensions shall be in accordance with the provisions of Transportation Code – Chapter 621.

It is further condition of this permit that Applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless the City for any damages caused to the person or property of third parties arising out of the operations of Applicant, his employees, agents, or subcontractors, under this permit.

This permit is further granted upon the condition that Applicant will comply with the laws of the State of Texas Governing his operation and upon his representation, that he has complied with the Safety Responsibility Act of the State of Texas. That he meets all other requirements of law, and further agrees to all rules and regulations of Jones Creek governing such roads and load limits as authorized by the laws of the State of Texas.

This permit is a revocable permit. Jones Creek reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time, in the sole discretion of Jones Creek, for interests of public health, safety or welfare, or for failure to pay road damages upon demand, or for any other reason deemed sufficient by Jones Creek.

The City of Jones Creek further retains the right to revoke this Permit by verbal notification to the Applicant and/or his company.
