SPECIAL HAULING APPLICATION/PERMIT**

APPLICATION FOR SPECIAL HAULING PERMIT: to move over Town Highways a vehicle or combination of vehicles exceeding the dimensions and weight as specified in Article 10, Section 385 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law.

Applicant may be required to post a security bond for repair and restoration of Town road(s) traveled as a term and condition of receiving this permit.

This permit does not allow the crossing of a posted bridge by an overweight vehicle. All vehicles must comply with restrictions on New York State Permits when traveling on Town Roads. All permits shall expire upon completion of the permitted use as described and approved herein.

As a condition of this permit, applicant agrees that no vehicle movements will be made on Saturdays, Sundays or Holidays, unless approved by the Superintendent of Highways, and that all movements will be limited to 7:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., when weather and road conditions are favorable. It is further agreed that any and all movements will be made in the manner provided by the law, and in accordance with the conditions and regulations as hereinafter set forth, all forming a part hereof to which the applicant agrees, and applicant further agrees by its acceptance of this permit to assume all responsibility and liability for damages to persons and/or property that may accrue during such movements through the negligence of himself, its agents or employees, or from any other cause, and agrees that it will hold the Town of Centerville harmless therefrom.

Applicant agrees to provide the Highway Superintendent with a Certificate of Liability Insurance in an amount not less than \$ _____, which certificate must expire not earlier than _____, 20____.

Applicant agrees to post a security bond for repair and restoration of Town road(s) traveled in an amount of \$ _____ as a term and condition of receiving this permit.

Permit Conditions:

Applicant is required to post a security bond in favor of the Town of Centerville in a minimum amount of \$ _____.

March 1 to May 1

1. If temperatures are below freezing for 24 hours, hauling may continue.
2. Temps below freezing at night then thawing, hauling must stop by 10 A.M.
3. Temps above freezing for 24 hours, hauler must check with Highway Superintendent for permission to haul. This will be waived after Superintendent determines that road base is stabilized.

July 1 to September 1

1. If road surface starts to "pick" hauler must notify Superintendent immediately and cease hauling until Highway Dept. can spread material on road or until temperatures cool enough to stabilize road surface.

Throughout Year

1. Hauler must notify Highway Superintendent of intent to haul and pick up permit to do so. This will allow the hauler to avoid any delays due to construction and also give written permission to haul on posted roads.

Article 11, Section 320 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law. Injuries to highways.

Whoever shall injure any highway or bridge maintained at the public expense, by obstructing or diverting any creek, water-course or sluice, or by dragging logs or timber on its surface or by drawing or propelling over the same a load of such weight as to injure or destroy the culverts or bridges along the same, or of such weight that will destroy, break or injure the surface of any improved state highway, county road or town highway, or by any other act, or shall injure, deface or destroy any mile-stone or guide-post erected on any highway, shall for every such offense forfeit treble damages.
