



Plumbing Work Installed by Homeowner

A homeowner may install plumbing only in a residence or accessory structure that he/she owns and occupies, or will occupy as his/her home, subject to the following:

Pertaining to the **Homeowner** doing the plumbing for said house, The Homeowner will do all the plumbing in the house to The State of Illinois Plumbing Code (77 Illinois Administrative Code, Part 890). **Any other person or persons other than the owner doing the work shall be subject to a fine per Illinois Plumbing License law for each offense.** If plumbing code violation seem to be extreme and the Homeowner is not capable of the proper installation of the plumbing, he/she shall hire a licensed plumber that is Licensed and Bonded with the Illinois Department of Public Health to change the code violations and finish the work.
