All Portable Storage Containers and dumpsters shall comply with the following requirements:

1. No person shall erect, place or maintain more than one (1) Portable Storage Container or dumpster on a single parcel unless the Code Official expressly permits in writing, in the Code Official's sole discretion, more than one (1) Portable Storage Container or dumpster on the property.
2. No person shall erect, place or maintain a Portable Storage Container or dumpster on property for a period exceeding seven (7) days unless the Code Official expressly permits in writing, in the Code Official's sole discretion, the Portable Storage Container or dumpster to remain on the property for a longer period of time.
3. No person shall erect, place or maintain a Portable Storage Container or dumpster in any area of a property other than a private driveway or an impervious surface located in the rear yard.
4. A Portable Storage Container or dumpster placed in the rear yard must be completely concealed from public view, and either be enclosed within an accessory structure or surrounded by permanent fencing or opaque landscaping materials.
5. No person shall erect, place or maintain a Portable Storage Container or dumpster for any period of time in a manner which may obstruct vehicular or pedestrian traffic in a right-of-way, sidewalk or other pedestrian path.
6. A Portable Storage Container or dumpster shall not be permitted to become so full that any items, trash or debris overflow out of the receptacle.
