In accordance with Local Law No. 5, Section 2, no person shall have, maintain or conduct live music outdoors in the Village of Voorheesville without having first applied for and received an Outdoor Music Entertainment Permit. The permitting period as a calendar year, January 1 to December 31, with a \$100 application fee. If the application is submitted after the second half of the calendar year the application fee is \$50.

Please note, in determining whether to issue an Outdoor Music Entertainment Permit, or to impose any conditions on the Permit, the Board of Trustees will consider:

- (1) Whether the proposed venue is reasonable in light of its location and layout; the nature of the event(s); and the anticipated size of any crowds;
- (2) Whether there is adequate parking and vehicular/pedestrian traffic control for the number of persons expected to attend the event(s);
- (3) Whether the event(s) are likely to unreasonably interfere with the activities of people living or working in the vicinity; cause injury to property; or create an unreasonable disturbance.

Applicant should provide sufficient detail and information to enable the Board of Trustees to make its determination. The Applicant may attach additional pages and documentation as it deems necessary.

By submitting an Outdoor Music Entertainment Permit application an applicant represents that it has read, is familiar with the requirements of, and will comply with the Village's "Outdoor Music Entertainment" and "Noise Control & Abatement" local laws.

Notice: Any changes to the information provided in this application must be reported to the Village Clerk within 10 business days or before the next event for which a license has been issued, whichever occurs first.
