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IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON APPLICATION FOR POOLS
SEASONAL OR PERMANENT

MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH A PLAN SHOWING

1. YARD SIZE
2. POOL SIZE AND DEPTH
3. DISTANCE TO ALL PROPERTY LINES
4. LOCATION OF FENCE AROUND POOL OR YARD
5. SEASONAL POOL – 5 FT FROM PROPERTY LINE
6. PERMANENT POOL – 10 FT FROM PROPERTY LINE
7. WATER USED TO FILL POOL WILL BE CHARGED IN SEWER RATE, UNLESS YOU HAVE A WATER DEDUCT METER. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!
8. ALL POOLS LESS THAN 4 FT IN HEIGHT MUST HAVE A CONTINUOUS FENCE OF 4' OR HIGHER
9. MUST CALL BUILDING INSPECTOR FOR FINAL INSPECTION BEFORE USE.
10. GFCI OUTLETS MUST BE LOCATED ON THE EXTERIOR OF THE PROPERTY. THE OUTLET MUST BE WITHIN 6 FT-10 FT OF A PERMANENT POOL AND WITHIN 6 FT TO 20 FT OF A TEMPORARY POOL.

Please note: The water used to fill and maintain swimming pools may cause an increase in your sanitary sewer bill. The Borough of Laureldale recommends the use of a deduct meter which must be acquired through the Muhlenberg Township Water Authority and paid for by the property owner.
