As the property owner or operator of the Digital/Electronic Message Board Sign, I hereby certify that I am aware of the City of Willard Sign regulations and safety measures for Digital/Electronic Message Board Signs and understand the following.

(INITIAL THE FOLLOWING)

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| ☐ Any digital/electronic message played on the display must remain <u>UNCHANGED</u> for a minimum of (6) seconds before the message may change. | ☐ Digital/Electronic Message Board Signs shall meet the size and placement requirements required by the City of Willard Sign Ordinance/Zoning Code . |
| ☐ The Code Enforcement Officer may deny or revoke the sign permit if the sign is found to have images that are too bright, the motion or changing of images too quickly, or distracting to motor vehicle traffic. | ☐ The Code Enforcement Officer may conduct occasional safety inspections of all digital/electronic signage to ensure all safety measures and zoning codes are being met. |
| ☐ The signs luminance shall not exceed 10,000 nits during the day from sunrise to sunset, and no more than 500 nits at night from sunset to sunrise | ☐ Police and Fire Department may conduct occasional safety inspections of all digital/electronic signage to ensure the safety of the public from potential distracting displays or other possible safety hazards. |
| ☐ The sign shall be equipped to freeze to a black screen if a malfunction occurs or easily accessed to power down if such an event requires it to be disabled. | |
| ☐ The property owner or sign operator must immediately power down or disable the message board sign when notified by the Code Enforcement Officer if or when the digital/electronic message board sign is not complying with all safety measures. | |
