Plans and specifications must be submitted when the wiring or alteration to an electrical system is over 400 amps and is in excess of 3,500 square feet in all buildings. Have plans been submitted? [] YES [] NO Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direction supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act #299 of the public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except: when electrical system does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 sq. feet. Plans must be submitted before permit is issued. If work is started before permit is applied for, an additional fee will be charged.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorize work in not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the date of issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be refunded or reinstated.
