



Subcontractor Validation Form

If a Building Permit has been submitted or issued for a project, subcontractors must validate onto the building permit instead of securing individual permits for each trade. The validation form must be signed by the registered subcontractor or one of the authorized designers of that subcontractor listed on the contractor registration form. The validation form must be submitted prior to the commencement of work by that subcontractor. Please specify the work to be performed – in some cases there may be multiple subcontractors of the same trade. Subcontractor validations may only be rescinded in writing.
