SALE REGULATIONS LOCAL LAW 3/84

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct any type sale without the proper permit.
- B. It shall be unlawful to sell goods not owned by the owner of the property.
- C. All sales shall be conducted between the hours of 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM on Friday or Saturday or both consecutively, in any given week only.
- D. No personal property sale or open house sale may be conducted on any property more than once within a twelve month period.
- E. No signs, posters, or other forms of advertising may be placed upon the real property upon which the sale is conducted prior to the day on which the sale is to be conducted.
- F. Advertising of personal property sales or open house sales shall be limited to newspapers published in Nassau and Suffolk Counties.
- G. The personal property and contents of a home which are the subject of a personal property sale, shall be displayed wholly within the interior of the dwelling or the garage where the sale is to take place, except for the sale of personal property which customarily has been located at the exterior of the dwelling or used outside the dwelling or the garage situated thereat.
- H. Application for a permit must be made at least fourteen (14) days prior to the scheduled date of sale.
- I. A permit issued pursuant to the provisions of this local law shall be conspicuously displayed at the premises at all times during such sale, and shall be exhibited to any person authorized to inspect same. The Village Clerk, Village Deputy Clerk, Building Inspector, a Police Officer, or any person designated by the Mayor, shall have the authority to inspect and direct the immediate cessation and closing of any sale in violation of this law.
