HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

_____, first being duly sworn on oath, deposes and says:

I am the applicant or authorized agent of an applicant for the Street Festival Permit pursuant to Chapter 38 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Pilot Mountain. I know and understand the risks inherent in establishing a street festival including, but not limited to: obstruction to traffic, slip and fall injuries, and collision with obstructions. I understand that in granting to me the aforementioned permit, the Town may become liable to others because of the risks, including but not limited to, the risks mentioned herein. In consideration for granting the aforementioned permit, I agree to forever defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Pilot Mountain, its selected and appointed officials, employees, volunteers, and agents from any and all claims, actions or damages of every kind and description which may accrue to, or be suffered by any persons by reason of or related to the street festival.

In addition, such agreement shall contain a provision that the permit is wholly of a temporary nature and that it vests no permanent right whatsoever.
