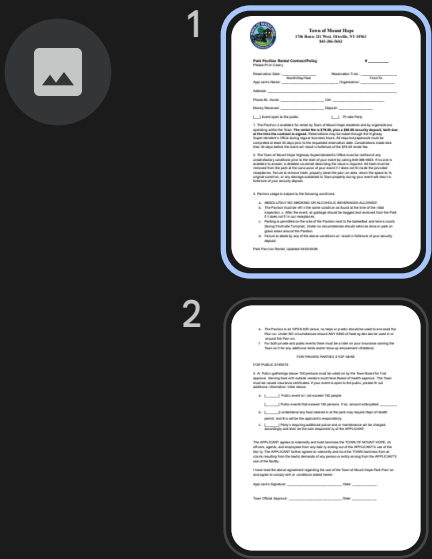

1. The Pavilion is available for rental by Town of Mount Hope residents and by organizations operating within the Town. **The rental fee is \$75.00, plus a \$50.00 security deposit, both due at the time the contract is signed.** Reservations may be made through the Highway Superintendent's Office during regular business hours. All required paperwork must be completed at least 30 days prior to the requested reservation date. Cancellations made less than 30 days before the event will result in forfeiture of the \$75.00 rental fee.

2. The Town of Mount Hope Highway Superintendent's Office must be notified of any unsatisfactory conditions prior to the start of your event by calling 845-386-5603. If no one is available to answer, a detailed voicemail describing the issue is required. All trash must be removed from the park at the conclusion of your event if it does not fit inside the provided receptacles. Failure to remove trash, properly clean the pavilion area, return the space to its original condition, or any damage sustained to Town property during your event will result in forfeiture of your security deposit
