Checklist of Items to Include with this Application:

Applications will only be considered complete once ALL items have been provided.

- ☐ Images of pool with the installation of the new item (cover and/or rainwater collection system)
- ☐ Receipts for the purchase of the pool cover and/or tanks and installation
- ☐ Plans detailing how the rainwater collection system is tied into the pool's auto refill features to reduce the impact of this function on the aquifer (if applicable)
- ☐ Additional supporting materials are welcome
- ☐ Scheduling and completion of the final inspection of the pool cover and/or rainwater collection system. Final report must be submitted.

Guidelines of the Program:

- This is a one-time rebate program.
- Receipts are required.
- A final inspection, at the owner's expense, is required to review that the system meets requirements and is functional.
- Installation of rainwater collection for the purpose of filling an existing pool, spa, swim spa, or hot tub:
 - This will not exceed \$7,500 per residency and cannot exceed half of the cost of total project installation.
 - Systems must show the capacity for consistent drawing on rainwater and support the needs of the aquatic installation in question.
 - Rainwater collection systems must have 10,000 gallons in capacity on the system
 - Roof size for catchment must be 500 square feet at minimum
 - Pool cannot exceed 400 square feet in surface area, or the minimum catchment size will double.
- Implement a rebate program policy for the purchase and installation of pool covers to reduce evaporation:
 - This would be no more than half of the cost of the cover purchase and installation.
 - It will not exceed \$1000 per residency.

NOTE: Process can take up to 4-6 weeks before reimbursement is received once an application is deemed complete.

Assistance will only be considered for work done within the 6 months prior to the application submission. Funds are available on a "first come, first served" basis from the budget. If the City has spent all the approved budgeted funds for the year, then assistance may not be available.

Applications subject to approval by staff. Funds will be issued if all requirements are met and funds are available.

If you are unable to provide some of the materials, then you may request review by City Council based on special circumstances. Additional supplemental items may be needed in this case.

Please be prepared to work with staff in a supportive manner.
