REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

- (1) Copy of approved food service permit from the Henry County Health Department (if applicable).
- (2) Proof of current liability insurance policy in the amount of \$100,000.00 for individual and \$500,000.00 for profit or non-profit organizations, to be effective during the time period for which the permit for transient selling is requested.
- (3) If Transient Merchant is operating on private property a written consent from the owner must be provided.
- (4) Signed authorization allowing the city to complete a criminal background check on the applicant.
- (5) Exact location in which applicant intends to do business.
- (6) A signed and notarized letter consenting to the soliciting and/or peddling activity from the Homeowner's Association (HOA) President in those communities that have HOA's.
- (7) At the time of filing application for a permit, the applicant shall present the driver's license of each person working.
- (8) No more than one individual person shall engage in business or operate under the same transient license.
