<u>NOTICE</u> All requests must include a stamped professional drawing of system to be installed. Fee waived during new construction of main building. It is the full responsibility of the property owner for any damage or repairs needed, resulting from damage or normal wear, to all portions of an irrigation system placed within city right-of-way or easements. The backflow device shall be installed directly after the water meter (outside of the City meter box), not more than five feet from the property line. The City may allow a variance to install the device so that it does not obstruct a sidewalk, driveway, or other public easement. The City Building department can assist you with exact placement. Ordinance 2014-20 adopted June 10, 2014. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and City of Midlothian Ordinance No. 2014-20, require that backflow prevention assemblies be tested upon installation and routinely thereafter, depending on degree of hazard. The test reports are required to be submitted to the Utility Billing Department, along with a processing fee, within five (5) days of testing. Backflow testers must be registered with the City of Midlothian prior to testing and annually thereafter.
