- (2) The date of the application

location of shutoff valves must be known in order for emergency responders to clear area for access valves.) To the extent that information can be obtained, drawings shall show the location of other pipelines and utilities that will be crossed or paralleled within five (5) feet of the proposed pipeline.

- (18) A description of the consideration given to matters of public safety and the avoidance, as far as practicable, of existing inhabited structures and congregated areas.
- (19) Detailed cross section drawings for all public street right-of-way and easement crossings.
- (20) Methods to be used to prevent both internal and external corrosion.
- (21) A binder or certificates of all bonds and insurance as required under this Article.
- (22) A tree survey of specimen trees prepared pursuant to Chapter 94, "Vegetation," Article II, "Trees," Section 94-91, "Application," as amended. A tree survey of specimen trees shall be required from the outer edge of any improvements, construction areas, development, equipment, materials, temporary roads, access easements, and/or built structures, extending twenty-five (25) feet, without regard to intervening structures or objects.
- (23) Map showing proposed transportation route and road for equipment, chemicals or waste products used or produced
- (24) Owner and address of each parcel of property within one thousand (1,000) feet of the proposed pipeline for public education as required by the Pipeline Ordinance.
