DUMPSTER PERMIT APPLICATION

PLACEMENT UPON A STREET, HIGHWAY, OR PUBLIC PROPERTY

Pursuant to Ordinance 2026-04, Section 1 "Dumpsters"

The property owner shall make every effort to place roll-off dumpsters on private property rather than on streets, highways, or public property. This application is required only where the only practical location for the dumpster is on a street, highway, or public property. No person shall park or leave an unattended roll-off dumpster on or along any municipal street, highway, or public property without first obtaining a permit from the Township.

Per Ordinance 2026-04(F), placement upon a street, highway, or public property may not exceed thirty (30) days from the date of approval. The permit may be renewed one time for an additional thirty (30) day period upon endorsement by the Zoning Officer and payment of a second \$50.00 fee.

7. SITE PLAN REQUIRED:

In accordance with Ordinance 2026-04(B), the applicant must attach a plan showing the proposed location of the dumpster, depicting nearby driveways, intersections, and property lines. Attach the plan to this application.

8. SAFETY DEVICES AND REFLECTIVE MARKERS:

Per Ordinance 2026-04(H), the dumpster shall be equipped with all-yellow reflective diamond-shaped panels measuring at least 18 inches by 18 inches, mounted at both ends nearest the path of passing vehicles and facing oncoming traffic, at a minimum mounting height of three (3) feet from the bottom of the panel to the roadway surface. The dumpster shall be covered with a tarpaulin or other industry-acceptable material at the end of each workday or during any prolonged period when not in use.

9. PROTECTION OF STREET SURFACE:

Per Ordinance 2026-04(I), the roll-off dumpster's wheels or skids shall be placed on timber material having minimum dimensions of not less than two (2) inches thick by twelve (12) inches wide by forty-eight (48) inches long, to protect the surface of the street, highway, or public property. This requirement does not relieve the property owner of responsibility for any further damage caused by the placement of the dumpster.

10. PLACEMENT RESTRICTIONS (Ordinance 2026-04(G)):

- No dumpster shall be placed within five (5) feet of an adjacent property owner's driveway.
- The portion of the street or roadway used shall not exceed one-third (1/3) of the width of the street or roadway.
- No dumpster shall be placed at the site more than 24 hours prior to construction, nor remain more than 24 hours after construction is completed.
- Upon removal, the street or roadway shall be swept clean of all loose debris and restored to its former condition.

11. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

The property owner must submit a copy of the declaration page of their homeowner's (or commercial) insurance policy along with this application, OR the dumpster/contracting company may provide a copy of its certificate of liability insurance naming the Township of North Hanover as an additional insured.

12. APPLICATION FEE AND INDEMNITY DEPOSIT (Ordinance 2026-04(E)):

A non-refundable permit fee of \$50.00 is due at the time of application (cash or check). The Township, in its discretion and upon advisement of the Construction/Zoning Office, may also require an indemnity deposit of \$500.00 to reimburse the Township for the cost of any extraordinary cleanup or repair resulting from the permitted use. The deposit, less any amount deducted for damage to Township property, will be returned following inspection upon permanent removal of the dumpster.

13. POLICE DEPARTMENT REVIEW:

Per Ordinance 2026-04(D)(2), before a permit may be issued, the application shall be reviewed and the proposed location inspected and photographed by a member of the North Hanover Police Department, who must certify that the placement will not create an unreasonable hazard or risk to the health, safety, or welfare of Township residents.

14. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:

I certify that the information provided in this application is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge. I understand that the permit, once issued, must be displayed prominently and in a conspicuous position on the property adjacent to the placement site for the duration of its use, and that the Township may revoke this permit or order removal of the dumpster at the owner's expense as provided in Ordinance 2026-04(J) and (K).
