Public Works Service Agreement

The following are terms of the service agreement between the City of Farwell and the water utility customer, of the City of Farwell.

- 1. The Farwell Public Works will maintain a copy of this agreement as long as the Customer and/or premises is connected to the Farwell water system.
- 2. The Customer shall allow his/her property to be inspected for possible cross connections and other undesirable plumbing practices. These inspections shall be conducted by the Farwell Public Works or its designated agent prior to initiating service and periodically thereafter. The inspections shall be conducted during the City's normal business hours.
- 3. The Farwell Public Works shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross connection or other undesirable practice which has been identified during the initial inspection or the periodic reinspection.
- 4. The Customer shall immediately correct any undesirable plumbing practice on his/her premises.
- 5. The Customer shall, at his/her expense, properly install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the Farwell Public Works.
 - a. No pipe or pipe fitting which contains more than 0.25% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
 - b. No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2% lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
- 6. The Customer is responsible for contacting the City Hall to terminate the account when they are moving out of the residence.

ENFORCEMENT

For Outside City limit customers requesting water service, by signing below you agree to refrain from any and all use of the City of Farwell roll-off containers and/or any dumpster containers within the city limits. Use of either of the two shall result in immediate filing of Theft of Services against you.

If you fail to comply with the terms of this Service Agreement, the Farwell Public Works, at its option, will either terminate service or properly install, test, and maintain an appropriate backflow prevention device at the service connection. Any expenses associated with the enforcement of this agreement shall be billed to the Customer.
