Applicants must file with the Department of Public Works at the time of filing of the application the following:

1. Construction Plans and specifications signed and sealed by a New York State License Professional Engineer that depict the extent of the excavation work as well as provide details for trenching and roadway restoration, as acceptable to the Village Engineer.
2. A liability insurance policy, naming the Village of Brewster Insured or additional insured and insuring said Village of Brewster against liability for damages or injuries in the amounts of \$1,000,000 maximum for each person and \$2,000,000 maximum for each accident and against liability for property damage in the amount of not less than \$100,000 and said policy of insurance shall contain a clause stating that it shall remain in full force and effect until the expiration thereof and that it shall not be modified, suspended or cancelled for any cause except after 10 days written notice of same has been duly served upon said Village of Brewster.
3. A "Letter of Credit" in an amount sufficient to secure the cost of the Village of restoring the street/sidewalk to the same condition it was in prior to excavation, as acceptable to the Village Engineer.
4. No permit shall be issues, or be valid if issued, until the above provisions are complied with.
5. The Applicant agrees to and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Village of Brewster against and from any and all liability, injury, damage and cost whatsoever arising from or related to, directly or indirectly, the work.
